**FAST FACTS:**

**Q. How will High Holiday (HHD) services be offered this year?**

A. Some services will be virtual only, but many will be in-person. All in-person services will be available on livestream and Zoom.

**Q. Who may attend HHD services in-person?**

A. All Members and non-members (who have purchased tickets) may attend HHD services in the building provided they are fully vaccinated (12 and over), are not showing any symptoms of COVID-19, and fill out the registration form on page 5. Masks are required for all attendees over the age of 2 regardless of vaccination status. The registration form should be returned to the office via mail or email at [bporter@shaaretefila.org](mailto:bporter@shaaretefila.org). **Q. What about my children who aren't vaccinated?**

A. Unvaccinated children under 12 years of age may still attend services with their vaccinated parents. They must be masked if over the age of 2.

**Q. A non-Shaare Tefila family wants to join us for services this year; can I purchase attendance at our services for them?**

A. **Yes!** Any member who wishes to purchase tickets for non-members to attend services either in-person or via Zoom can do so, but note payment for the tickets must be made in full before the holiday. Please contact the office with any questions.

**Q. When will I receive my Zoom link for services?**

A. You will receive an email approximately one week before HHDs. This email will also include the schedule of services and other pertinent information. Please keep all emails for reference.

**Q. Will I be able to borrow a machzor this year if I choose to attend services on Zoom?**

A. No. You will need to purchase a machzor this year for use at home if you don't already have one.

Currently the Machzor Lev Shalem is on sale for \$29.40 per copy + shipping. No code needed.

A **10% discount** will be given to any household that pays its entire Building Fund obligation within 6 months of the start of its obligation.**Congregation Policy:**

1/3 of the current year's dues, 1/3 of religious school tuition (*if applicable*), full payment for voluntary donations as well as all past due balances must be paid in full in order for High Holiday seats and Zoom to be included unless under a special arrangement.
